### Bible Study

We read Phil: 2:1 – 11 and discussed this reading and how it related to Zion. Below are some of the things that we talked about.

- Put others first – are we doing that?
- Start with the point of view of being humble
- Being united and Like, Minded
- Being of one in Spirit and Purpose
- What is our attitude?
- Humility – Being asked to join? How do we do this.

The concept of our Head to Heart program was talked about. First we have to get the Holy Spirit into someone's heart then it goes to their head; having people believe in Jesus, therefore acting on that belief and coming to church.

We also discussed our Prayer Partner program, where the confirmands would have someone be their prayer partner throughout their learning process. The partners would send notes, small gifts, etc. and at the end of the year have a Prayer Partner revealing. Also the Prayer Chain was discussed and explained how it works.

The discussion went into the Power of Prayer and how to connect with other people in the congregation. The Transition Team wants the congregation to have the same feeling of optimism that we have and not get discouraged. Zion had a challenge that has past and now we are on the upswing, moving toward the future. Using the following as an example: Zion was in Critical Care and now we are in Physical Therapy on our way to healing.

We discussed how to get the information out to the congregation and decided that we would have a TT member read the devotion and the notes from the meetings, along with an ending prayer; and to the present members, those that have left and went to another church and those members that want to come back but are unsure.

The Transition Team is looking at sending out questionnaires to the members of Zion, to make sure we are going in the right direction.
