V. 12: Put on then, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, compassionate hearts, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience,

V. 13 (last line) as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive.

V. 15 And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body. And be thankful.

- Re-open the Bowling Alley
- Have concerts in the school
- Relay for Life
- Have a yearly fundraiser
- Golf Outing

We discussed developing an Evangelism Team, and how do we get parents of the Day Care, School Children involved in our church in today's society.

We as congregation members have to be more visible to everyone at the Day School, like attending the basketball games and other athletic sports. This would help the parents become familiar with the other members not just the parents of the school children.
