Rev. Mandla J. Khumalo, pastor and bishop of St. Peter Confessional Lutheran Church, Middelburg, South Africa, has been invited by the Michigan District, LCMS as a visiting missionary and evangelist for a two-year stay. He, his wife Lindiwe, and grandson Nhlaka (nickname NK) have moved to Lansing where they will be sharing the Gospel and traveling around the state. Pastor Khumalo's message is one that encourages us in evangelism, racial reconciliation through the power of the Gospel, and furthers the Great Commission to make disciples of all nations.

Pastor Khumalo studied at Concordia Theological Seminary in Ft. Wayne, Ind., and was ordained by the bishop of our partner church in South Africa, David Tswaedi, in 1989 before founding St. Peter Confessional Lutheran Church in Mhluzi, Middelburg, South Africa. Today, St. Peter has a worship attendance of nearly 1,000 each weekend and has 10 satellite congregations and preaching stations. The church also operates a Lutheran preschool (Bethel Preschool) and grade school (St. Peter Christian College) which has over 600 students.

Please join our Zion family this coming weekend, August 17-19, to hear Rev. Dr. Mandla Khumalo share his message of hope and salvation with our church family during our Saturday evening, Sunday morning, and Monday evening worship services.
